## Supplies

- □ 6 pack or higher glue sticks
- □ 3 boxes of tissues
- □ 1 box of gallon ziploc bags
- □ 1 package of highlighters
- □ 1 package of black Expo markers
- □ 1 box of number 2 pencils
- □ 1 box of 24 count crayons
- □ 1 box of colored pencils
- □ 1 box of thin markers
- □ 1 box of thick markers
- □ 6 big pink erasers (these typically come in a two pack)
- □ 3 three-pronged green folders
- □ Sketch Pad for second grade room (*This can be just a single subject notebook.*)

## Additional Supplies

- □ Sturdy Art Journal: Bound sketchbook, NOT glued tablet or spiral bound notebook type. - Art Smock
- □ P.E. Shoes (to be kept in locker)
- □ Headphones (these need to stay at school)
- Backpack
- □ Homework Binder (size 8.5 x 5.5- if yours from last year is in good condition you may use it)
