Supplies

- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons (regular colors)
- 1 box of 12 Crayola colored pencils (regular colors)
- 1 box of 8 regular size Crayola washable markers (regular colors, no scented markers)
- 1 box of 8 fine-point Crayola washable markers (regular colors, no scented markers)
- 1 small pair of scissors
- 2 small pink erasers
- 1 package of pre-sharpened No. 2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 6 glue sticks
- 6 pack of thick blue or black dry erase markers
- 1 drawing journal for free time
- 4 boxes of tissues
- 4 blue, two pocket, plain folders with fasteners
- 2 packages of napkins (at least 150 count)

Additional Supplies

- 1 **homework binder** -This should be a 5 ½ by 8 ½” binder. These can be purchased from Staples for around \$8.59 at the following link. You may choose any of the 7 color options.
