Supplies

- 1 box of Crayola colored pencils (12 count)
- 1 package Crayola Classic markers (8 count)
- 1 pair of school scissors
- 1 - 1 1/2" three ring binder (solid colored)
- 2 dozen #2 lead pencils
- 1 package of wide-ruled filler notebook paper
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 large pink pencil eraser
- 1 package of highlighters
- 1 package of thin expo dry erase markers
- 4 plastic, pocket and prong folders (purple)
- 4 plastic, 3-hole pocket folders (solid color, no prongs)
- 1 box of gallon-sized Ziploc bags
- 2 160 count packages of quilted napkins
- 4 packages of 40 count paper plates (uncoated)

Additional Supplies
