Evansville Day School Archery

Evansville Day School is providing students with an archery program again this school year; 2018-2019

This is NASP tournament style archery, shooting at 10 and 15 meters. More information can be found at: http://naspschools.org/

Archers will learn all safety rules, how to score, and participate in local tournaments from our certified coach Joe Lagenour. Archery is a great sport to promote focus, concentration, discipline, confidence, and personal responsibility.

You do not need to have any prior experience.

This is our fifth year offering archery in our school and we are fortunate to have the same coaches working with our students as last year. ©

We will likely practice once a week in the beginning, unless the coach(s) feels that it would be beneficial to have more than one a week. We are looking at Saturday morning practices and/or after school practices possibly early evening with the day of the week to be determined soon. Please see the list provided on one of the other forms sent to you for additional practice locations if a practice is missed. The first practice will begin on Saturday October 13, 2018.

Archery is not like other sports where there is a season game schedule laid out in advance. Rather, schools host tournaments with open registration and invite other teams to attend. There is not a list available at this time however we try to attend one the first weekend of December and one each weekend from January 2019 through the State Tournament that is March 9, 2019.

We will shoot a qualifier sometime between 1/15/2019 and 2/20 2019 which may be one of the ones listed, or may be a new date.

- Regardless of the number of team members that qualify to go to the NASP State Tournament we will
 continue to attend meets until the end of March 2019. <u>Important</u> You must shoot in the qualifier
 meet to be eligible to go to state.
- Although you are not required to shoot at every scheduled meet, please make every attempt to do so. Your team will need you! ☺
- Students are registered as individual archers for each tournament.

You are responsible for getting yourself to each tournament, although we can try to arrange carpools.

At the tournament, archers are assigned a "flight time". You will know this time a few days ahead of the tournament. This is your time to compete. You will shoot for about 1 hour. Generally, the schools try to get all archers on the same team into the same flight time, or into close flight times.

Each archer is responsible for paying an entry fee for each tournament in which they wish to participate. Most schools charge about \$6.

State and national fees are higher (around \$15 - \$30 per archer).

We will use NASP regulation bows, which are the stock (original) <u>unmodified</u> Genesis bow. Genesis Mini and Pro are not allowed.

We do have some equipment for the team, but you may want to consider purchasing your own bow. The advantage of your own bow is that it will be configured to you, will provide the best consistency for your best performance, and allow you schedule extra practice on your own. Prices range from \$145 - \$190, mostly depending upon color, vendor, and bundle packages. I have included the information on types needed on a separate informational sheet.

The team will purchase team shirts; we will try to stay in the \$25- \$40 dollar range. Archers will wear their team shirts and jeans/pants to tournaments. I have included a form to record your student's shirt size and size chart of the anticipated shirt style.

There will be a participation fee to help cover costs beyond the shirts of \$60.00.

Evansville Day School held it's first archery meet on January 26- 27, 2018 at in our school gym. We anticipate holding another in 2019; possibly the evening of January 25 and partial day on January 26, 2019. Many area schools' teams are not able to register for area meets due to limited enrollment opportunities so the need for additional meets is great. We will need volunteers for several tasks and I will send out an email for a planning meeting via EDS email-newsletters. Our hosting an archery meet is a great opportunity to showcase to the community that Evansville Day School supports archery in the school just as many in the area do and funds to grow such a valuable program.
