Portrait of a Graduate:

We recognize that in order for our students to be successful in the current global economy, we need to help them be much more than a test score. What is needed to align our teaching and learning with our school's mission and vision is to paint a Portrait of a Graduate, which identifies main qualities and skills our graduates possess: entrepreneurial learners who are globally minded, resilient, and balanced.

Intersession: Each spring, every student participates in a week-long immersive and exploratory program called Intersession. Students choose from an array of options and topics about which they would like to learn. Often a travel component and/or opportunities for community service are included.

Other Opportunities: A House System and Student Leadership Program are being established this year, which will further students' opportunites for leadership roles.

Students have the opportunity to self-study to take AP tests for other courses.

GRADING POLICY

Evansville Day School does not rank students by academic standing. Grades are weighted by .33 for successful completion of dual credit and AP classes. AP students must sit for the exam to earn the weighted grade.
