### Individual Supplies:

- 1 **white** 2 inch view binder with pockets for 8 1/2 x 11 size paper
- 1 2pk of highlighters- any color
- 3 2-pocket yellow folders with fasteners
- 1 4pk Elmer's glue sticks \*
- 1 box of No. 2 pencils\* (no mechanical pencils, or pencil sharpeners please)
- 2 Pink Pearl erasers
- 1 package of 200 count paper plates\*
- 1 box Classic Crayola Markers (Broad line) \*
- 1 box Classic Crayola Markers (Fine line) \*
- 2 packages of 3 x 5 colored index cards \*

\*Items will be combined for class use

Individual art boxes and other supplies will be provided by the school. **Please purchase only the items included on the list.** Any additional items brought to school will be returned home. Thank you!

### Additional Supplies: (May reuse items, please see notes below)

- 1 **homework binder** -This should be a 5 1/2 by 8 1/2" binder. These can be purchased from Staples for around \$8.59 at the following link. You may choose any of the 7 color options. Please make sure it includes a pocket inside. - Art Journal** – Canson and Blick bound sketchbook available online at <http://www.dickblick.com/products/blick-hardbound-sketchbook/>
- Art Smock** – Easy to put on/take-off, preferably long sleeves and loose fitting. Suggestions include an old button down shirt or The Little Artist Smock found online at <http://www.shop.thelittleartist.com/>.
- One pair of small, plain earphones** in a 1 gallon Ziploc Bag labeled with name (no earbuds or large headphones please)
- One mini flashlight** with a back-up pack of appropriate **batteries**
- Gym Shoes** to be kept in locker
- Backpack** that will fit in locker- **no wheels**
- Water bottle** to be kept on desk in cup holder (3 1/4 in. diameter)

**Lockers:** Primary school teachers ask that students **not** bring decorative items for the lockers; for example, gel clings, stickers, magnets, dry erase boards, photographs, hanging lamps, and rugs. While these things are fun for students, they create unnecessary distractions during the school day. Locker shelves will be permitted to help students separate and organize supplies, but any other novelty items will be sent home.

**Additional Notes:** If you own a small binder from last year that is still in good condition, you may use that instead of purchasing a new one. The same rule applies to the sketchbook for art class. If you have several pages left in your art journal, you may continue to use it for the new school year. Thank you!
