A scholarship for families in higher education brought to you by Evansville Day School.

Evansville Day School, the only independent school in the tri-state area, is pleased to announce a scholarship opportunity for students whose families are employed by Youth First.

Any student who is admitted to Evansville Day School will automatically receive a 50% (25% for Junior Pre-K and Pre-K) tuition reduction.

Why is this scholarship being offered?

Evansville Day School understands educators have chosen a profession with immeasurable societal impact, but with lower salary benefits than other fields requiring similar degrees and work demands. As the leading college prep school in the region, we want to partner with educators by making Day School affordable to those families who value our [mission](#) and brand of education.

Who is eligible for this scholarship?

Any mission-appropriate (as determined by the [admission process](#)) student whose parent(s) work full or part-time for the Youth First at the time of enrollment.

What is the amount of the scholarship?

Scholarships are awarded as a percentage (25% for Junior Pre-K & Pre-K; 50% for K-Grade 12) and therefore depend upon grade level. Full tuition ranges from \$10,710 (Preschool, full-time) to \$16,710 (grades 8-12).

Is this a one-time award?

No. Scholarships are automatically renewed annually.

What is the scholarship deadline?

There is no specific deadline to apply for admission, or to apply for this scholarship, however; applicants are encouraged to apply early as several grade levels fill up prior to the start of school.

Are scholarship recipients also eligible to apply for need-based financial aid?

Yes. The scholarship is a minimum amount of tuition reduction. If the Flexible Tuition (tuition assistance) process demonstrates additional need, the school grants the family the larger award. Tuition assistance is not available in Junior Pre-K and Pre-K (beyond the 25% scholarship).
