Any student who is admitted to Evansville Day School will automatically received a 50% (25% for Junior Pre-K and Pre-K) tuition reduction.



Evansville Day School, the only independent school in the Tri-State area, is pleased to announce a scholarship opportunity for students whose families are employed full-time by Youth First.

Why is this Scholarship being offered?

Evansville Day School understands educators have chosen a profession with immeasurable societal impact, but with lower salary benefits than other fields requiring similar degrees and work demands. As the leading college prep school in the region, we want to partner with educators by making Day School affordable to those families who value our mission and brand of education.

Who is eligible for this scholarship?

Any mission-appropriate (as determined by the admission process) student whose parent(s) work full-time for Youth First at the time of enrollment.

What is the amount of the scholarship?

Scholarships are awarded as a percentage (25% for Junior Pre-K & Pre-K; 50% for K-12).

Is this a one-time award?

No. Scholarships are automatically renewed annually.

What is the scholarship deadline?

There is no specific deadline to apply for admission, or to apply for this scholarship. Applicants are encouraged to apply early, as several grade levels fill up prior to the start of school.

Can scholarship recipients also apply for need-based financial aid?

Yes. The scholarship is a minimum amount of tuition reduction. If the tuition assistance process demonstrates additional need, the school grants the family the larger award. Tuition assistance is not available in Junior Pre-K and Pre-K (beyond the 25% scholarship).
